



**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
May 2, 2022
ARTICLES OF WARRANT**

Greetings: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Starks, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Starks Community Center in the said Town of Starks on Monday, May 2nd, 2022 at 6:30 PM for a Special Town Meeting.

Article #1: To choose a moderator to preside at said Town Meeting.

Article #2: To see if the Town will vote to accept the sum of **\$17,354.27 from the Locke Cemetery Association** as a perpetual care fund for the so-called Locke Cemetery as accepted by the Town, and to place it in the Town's Cemetery Account to be handled in like fashion as other perpetual care funds.

Article #3: To see if the Town will appropriate from the Capital Improvement Reserve the sum of **\$55,000**; appropriate from surplus **\$55,000**; and raise and appropriate from taxation the sum of **\$30,000** for the purchase of a new Hitachi front-end loader.

Note: The Capital Reserve balance is currently **\$55,036.21**.

Article #4: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate **\$81,000** from the Capital Roads Account for the purpose of improving drainage and re-building two sections of the Mayhew Road totaling four thousand feet.


Note: The Capital Roads Account balance is currently **\$152,715.17**.

Article #5: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation **\$3,000** for updating the Town's tax maps.

Article #6: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation an additional **\$3,000** for the back-up generator project at the Starks Community Center.

Note: The Town appropriated **\$15,000** at the annual town meeting in March, but the price of the generator has increased from about **\$12,000** to about **\$17,000**.




